Students Promotion Policy

GENERAL

School promotion policy is the integral part that provides with the standard and guidelines for the promotion / retention of a student. Generally, the promotion takes place at the end of each academic year, based on the final cumulative result tabulated on the basis of 15% , 25% and 60% marks obtained in First , Second and Third term exams respectively. Send-up and Pre-Board exams are conducted for the students of board classes.

General Rules for promotion upto 9th grade

- a. Pass percentage must be 40%, and shall be calculated on aggregate basis.
- b. A student has to appear in all the terms for promotion to next class, however if a student got admission after first term or during the Second term, the weight-age will be given in the final exam, but no rank will be awarded to such students.
- c. If a student got admission after second term, will repeat the same class in the next academic session, however In case of genuine reason the weightage of the total marks will be considered for the promotion & in such case student must obtain minimum 60% aggregate marks.
- d. If a student fails to appear in any subject of any term exam due to any reason, weight-age will be given provided he/she has prior approval from the Principal and no rank will be awarded to such students.
- e. If a student is found involved in cheating in any paper. The case will be referred to the Exam supervising committee with the note of exam supervisor. The exam supervising committee will make the final decision.
- f. There shall not be any detention in KG classes.

- g. From grades 1st to 7th, if a Student fails in any one subject except major subjects (Urdu/Arabic , English, Maths and G. Science) he / she will be promoted to next class otherwise he/she will have to repeat the same class.
- h. If a student fails in 2 subjects, he / she may be given grace upto 37 marks. If a student fails in 2 major & 1 minor subject, he/ she will be allowed to take remedial classes & after a month. Exam will be held. The school will arrange remedial classes in 3 subjects weekly as scheduled below
- Maths - 1 lecture daily
 - English -2 lecture daily
 - Urdu -2 lecture daily
- i. Student must pass all the subjects to be eligible for promotion from 8th to 9th class. However, if a student fails in any one subject having marks between 35 to 40 in the failed subject can be promoted to next class but science stream in 9th class will not be offered to such students.
- j. Any student fails twice in any class, will be treated as per clause 'h'. if a student is going through any psychological disorder , the school can prepare separate scheme of studies . In such cases the student will be allowed only to continue up till grade 8th .
- k. From 9th to 10th and from 11th to 12th grade, if a student fails in three or more subjects must repeat the same class after cancellation of result from federal board.
- l. From the next Academic session, It will be mandatory for students to memorize table upto 10 & 10 last Surah, plus 6 kalimahs & entire Namaz at the end of grade 3. HOD's & subject teachers are required to put it in scheme of studies.
- m. Admission for over aged students, the SIT team has decided that the students will be offered admissions in the class as per his / her age & he / she has to complete the course of the pervious classes in minimum 3 months time. The teacher has to provide the entire course plan to the students. Exams will be held at the end of the course completion.

n. It will be ensured that entire course of the 8th class offered to Pre 9th students must complete in first two terms, promotion and stream will be offered based on the two terms results. Concerned HOD is responsible to prepare scheme of studies.

o. Marks scheme for students from grade 1 to 8 shall be as follows,

- 30 % internal & 70% external

Internal assessment is further distributed as per following criteria

- Attendance 5 marks
- Behaviour 5 marks
- Project 5 marks
- Monthly test 15 marks

p. Weighted for 9th to 12th grade to be eligible to appear in Board Exams.

- Sendup : 50%
- Monthly Test : 20%
- Attendance : 10%
- Project Marks : 10%
- Behaviour : 10%

q. The admission in different group of SSC will be further subject to obtaining a minimum grade in 8th standard is as under :

Science Group At least Grade B or 60% aggregate or above

Humanities Group Less than 60% aggregate

r. The admission in different group of HSSC will be further subject to obtaining a minimum grade in 10th standard is as under :

Pre Medical/ Pre-Engineering Group Grade B and Above

Science General Group Grade B and Above

Commerce Group Grade C and Above

Humanities Group Grade D and Above

s. 75 % attendance is must for students to appear as a regular in FBISE exams.
