UNIT 1: THE SAVIOUR OF MANKIND

Page: 2-4.

- > Makkah is situated about 50 miles from Red sea, the birth city of Prophet Muhammad(S.A.W).
- > Arabs possessed remarkable memory and eloquent poetry.
- > Poetical competitions were held at Ukaz every year.
- > Caliph Walid bin Yazid could recite 100 long poems for each letter of the alphabet.
- Due to their eloquence in Arabic language Allah chose the same language for the revelation of Holy Quran.
- > In the 5th and 6th centuries mankind stood on the verge of chaos.
- At this point, Allah Almighty raised a Prophet among themselves to lift the humanity from ignorance into to the light of faith.
- > First revelation 38 years of age meditation in the cave of Hira.
- > One day Angel Jibril(A.S.) came with the first revelation (Surah-al-Alaq Verse:1-5)
- \succ The first revelation was:

Read in the name of thy Lord Who created; created man from a clot (of congealed blood); Read and thy Lord is Most Bountiful, Who taught (the use of) the pen, taught man that which he knew not. (Quran, 96:1-5)


- The revelation continued for next 23 years with the proclamation of Tauheed and unity of mankind.
- This belief threatened the dominance of the disbelieving Arabs so they started opposing Prophet(SAW).
- They approached Abu Talib to advice him to stop preaching Allah Almighty's message or face their enmity.
- The response of Prophet (SAW) was : "My dear uncle, if they put the sun in my right hand and the moon in my left, even then I shall not abandon the proclamation of the Oneness of Allah (Tauheed). I shall set up the true faith upon the earth or perish in the attempt."
- The Prophet (SAW) encountered all challenges and came out successful in spreading Islam across Arabia and far.
- In reply to a question about the life of the Prophet(SAW), Hazrat Ayesha (RA) said: "His morals and character are an embodiment of the Holy Quran."
- > The final word about the saviour of mankind goes to the Holy Quran:

O Nabi! Surely, We have sent you as a witness, and a bearer of good news and as a warner. And as one inviting to Allah by His permission, and as a lightgiving torch. (Quran, 33:45-46) Page 6 Exercise B (Copy the question and answers from the notes uploaded at website)




3.1 Affixation

- Suffixes change part of speech



Example: The big blue spaceship zoomed into the sky. The flames were hot and bright and everyone was happy


