- The English-language word commerce has been derived from the Latin word commercium, from cum ("together") and merx ("merchandise"). The word then got converted to French language to finally give us "Commerce" which essentially means facilitating trading or allowing for exchange of goods and services.

Commerce/

def: Buying, selling and trading of goods on a large scale between people in different countries or states

Meaning of Commerce Education

- So,
- According to C.V.Good, "Business Education is 1. That area of education which develops skills, attitudes and understanding essential for the successful direction of business relationships.
- 2. An area of study dealing with the principles and practices of teaching business subjects".

Human Activity

Work done by human beings to satisfy their wants or needs is known as humam activity.

Kinds of human activities

Un-commanded activities include all those activities, taking place in the body, where we have no control of our own, e.g., the palpitation of heart and the working of stomach etc.

The activities in which human desire plays an important part i.e., speaking, walking and thinking, etc. are called commanded human activities.

INTERNAL ACTS - refer to the purely mental facilities under the command of the will. **EXTERNAL ACTS** acts are done by the body as commanded by the will. MIXED

 mixed acts are those done by bodily and mental powers.


Examples of commanded human activites or functions.

Commanded acts are those done either by man 's mental or bodily powers under the command of the will. It is either internal or external actions.

Examples internal actions are conscious reasoning, recalling something, encoura ging oneself, controlling arouse emotions and others.

These include all commercial and industrial activities which are connected with the production and or acquisition of wealth. These are also known as *productive activities* and are consisted of production and distribution of goods and services for earning profit.

Economic activities can be classified into three types:

kinds of economic Activities

1) <u>Business:</u>

- Any legal activity undertaken or performed for the purpose of earning profit is called business.
- 2) <u>Profession:</u>When a person provides his services to society on the basis of his specialized knowledge and experience in a particular field, it is known as profession (e.g.) doctors, professors, engineers and accountants etc.

- 3)Employment:When a person provides his services to another person or any institution on the basis of predetermined terms and conditions (fixed salary) is known as or employment or service This may be of three types:
- (a) Government Service
- (b) Semi Government Service
- (c) Private Service
