Origin of civics

- ▶ Greek. the great master Aristotle was the founder of Civics
- ▶ The word civics derived from Latin root civicus meaning relating to citizen
- ▶ Greeks used the word civis for cities and civitaz for citizens.
- ▶ Greek was a mountainous land and consist of small city states.

Definitions

F.J. Gould (1885 -1938) defines civics as
“the study of institutions , habits and spirits
by means of which a man or woman
(citizens) may fulfil the duties and receive
the benefits of membership in a political
community .

What is civics?

- ▶ Civics is the study of the theoretical , political and practical aspects of citizenship.
- ▶ Rights , duties and responsibilities of citizenship

Rights and duties

Civics can teach us about the rights granting to citizen as well as their responsibilities , such as serving on juries and engaging in the political process

Civics is the study of Rights ,duties and responsibilities of citizenship.

What is meant by RIGHT/DUTY

RIGHT

right is a moral or legal entitlement to have or do something.

Duty

Duty means , a moral or legal obligation , a responsibility.

Or a task or actions that one is required to perform as part of ones job

Some rights of the citizen

- ▶ Freedom to express yourself.
- ▶ Freedom to worship as you wish.
- ▶ Right to vote in elections for public officials.
- ▶ Right to prompt ,fair trail by jury.
- ▶ Right to apply for official jobs.
- ▶ Right to run for elected office.
- ▶ Freedom to pursue “life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness etc.

Rights and Duties of Citizens:

- ❖ With the emergence of Pakistan , rights of citizens were acknowledged and emphasized on the duties of citizens.
- ❖ Rights and Duties are correlative. When a person does his duties, he deserves to enjoy rights.
- ❖ Duties cover both individual and collective aspects of man.
- ❖ Mutual balance between rights and duties makes a state successful.
- ❖ Equal rights for minorities to be fully protected in Pakistan.

Some important duties of citizens

- ▶ Support and defend the constitution.
- ▶ Stay informed of the issues affecting your community.
- ▶ Participate in the democratic process.
- ▶ Respect and obey laws of the country,
- ▶ Respect the rights, beliefs and opinions of the others.
- ▶ Participate in your local community.
- ▶ Pay income and other taxes honestly and on time.
- ▶ Serve on jury when called upon..
- ▶ Defend the country if the need should arise.
