Laws of Economics

- An economic law is a generalization about the economic behaviour of the people which establishes relationship between some cause and its effects in economic matters.

Features of economic laws:

- A kind of scientific laws.
- Generalized.
- Statement of tendencies of people.
- They are conditional.
- Economic laws are not exact.
- In understanding economic events.
- Not immediately applicable.
